The competition is open to persons who meet the conditions specified in Article 113 of the Law on Higher Education and Science of July 20, 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2023, item.742, as amended).

Requirements:

- a post-doctoral degree (habilitation or equivalent) in social sciences in the discipline of sociology;
- familiarity with qualitative methods in interdisciplinary research;

• scholarly achievements, including at least five original articles published in internationally recognized peer-reviewed journals (particularly those listed in the Journal Citation Reports), and at least one book published in an internationally recognized publishing house.

- academic achievements in the field of historical sociology;
- participation as a project leader or contractor in research projects funded from non-university sources;
- active participation in academic life manifested in presentations at national and international conferences;
- very good command of the English language;
- knowledge of the Polish language allowing to conduct teaching activities;
- knowledge of a minimum of one additional source language.

Additional competences welcomed:

• research experience abroad, including at least one year in a foreign research center;

Responsibilities:

- participating in team-based research;
- applying for European and national grants;
- building an international professional network;
- publishing scholarly papers in international journals;
- strengthening the institute's presence and position in strategically defined areas;
- developing course curricula and teaching;
- participating in the administrative work of the unit.
